CORRELATION OF VISUAL AND VERBAL COMPONENTS IN POLYCODE TEXTS OF CHINESE PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

*Abstract.* The article presents an analysis of the discourse of the Chinese public service announcements, taking into account its national specifics, and analyses the correlation of verbal and visual components of polycode texts of public service announcements. The subject of the research is the national and cultural special features of the Chinese public service announcements discourse. CODING OF THE MASS MEDIA DISCURSIVE FORMAT OF KNOWLEDGE (A CASE STUDY OF THE PUBLICATIONS “LE MONDE” AND “ROSSIYSKAYA GAZETA”)

*Abstract.* The article discusses mass media discourse and provides the author's typology of discursive formats of knowledge. The coding features of the mass media discursive format of knowledge in two multilingual publications, the French newspaper "Le Monde" and the Russian publication "Rossiyskaya Gazeta" are revealed. The author's algorithm for encoding the mass media discursive format of knowledge, consisting of seven stages, is proposed. Projecting the author's coding algorithm onto articles in French and Russian newspapers revealed: 1) the number of articles in the "Culture" heading, the "Art" subheading in the publication "Rossiyskaya Gazeta" is five times greater than the number of articles in the newspaper "Le Monde" in the corresponding heading "Culture", subsection "Art", for the same period; 2) the number of coded components prevails in the titles of articles in a Russian language newspaper; 3) among the coded components, proxemes prevail in the articles of both newspapers.

**FORECASTING THE NEED FOR TEACHING STAFF IN THE EDUCATION SYSTEM USING THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKHSTAN AS A STUDY CASE**

*Abstract.* A methodology for forecasting the need for teaching staff in the education system is proposed using the example of the Republic of Kazakhstan based on a combination of statistical and analytical approaches. Analysis of forecast results shows an increase in the total number of students in the Republic of Kazakhstan by 400.9 thousand people by 2030, and by 656.5 thousand people by 2040 compared to 2022. The additional need for secondary schools by 2040, according to the main forecast with an accuracy of 95 %, is estimated at 443 schools. Taking into account the reduction of general education schools, which are engaged in several shifts, by 50 % increases the additional need for urban general education schools, according to the main forecast, by 2.5–3 times — up to 1316 schools. The additional need for teaching staff in secondary schools in Kazakhstan is estimated annually from 4.75 to 5.1 thousand people until 2040. The additional need for teaching staff in urban secondary schools is estimated at 5.2 to 5.3 thousand people.

**COMPLEXITY OF FORMULAS AND METHODS USED IN SOLVING SCHOOL TASKS (THE CASE OF ELECTRODYNAMICS)**

*Abstract.* The article describes the methodology for assessing the complexity of formulas and methods used in solving school problems in electrodynamics, analyzes the results obtained. Based on the content analysis of standard school textbooks and problem books, 6 topics have been identified, each of which corresponds to its own set of formulas and its own method of solving problems. The formulas were encoded with a verbal code and presented in a text file Formula.txt. For each of the 48 formulas, the number of terms was counted, their complexity was taken into account, which allowed to determine the semantic complexity and the coefficient of information convolution. The distributions of formulas and methods in the spaces “volume — complexity” and “average complexity — average coefficient of information convolution” are analysed. Based on the number of formulas in each method, the uncertainty of the choice of formulas and the corresponding complexity of the choice in the independent solution of problems in electrodynamics are estimated.
